We warmly welcome all our honored guests, brethren, sisters, friends, and supporters to this celebration of Solidarity Lodge No. 1457's 20th anniversary of its constitution as a lodge by the Most Worshipful Grand Lodge of Texas.

The past 20 years have seen tremendous growth in lodge membership. From a fledgling lodge of a mere 57 brethren, we have now swelled to 98 strong. Our fraternal activities have also expanded to include: Masonic education, family picnics, fund-raising events, Valentine's Day and Mothers' Day celebrations for our ladies, Golden Trowel Award and Community Builder Award ceremonies, attendance at the Grand Communication in Waco, Christmas Party, and a visit to the Masonic Retirement Center in Arlington, Texas.

Our community-directed efforts have also grown in scale. We continued to hold very successful semi-annual blood drives, where we average 70 units of blood collected each time, and provide refreshment to 500- 700 parishioners for 9 straight days during the *Simbang Gabi* celebration at Notre Dame Catholic Church. Recently, the lodge coordinated a Houston-wide blood drive involving all the 48 lodges within the city, and all the four not-for-profit blood centers in the area. This blood drive attracted 249 donors and yielded 190 units of blood. We also raised funds and gathered relief goods for the victims of the recent devastating earthquake and typhoon in the Philippines.

We realize that we cannot sit on our past laurels as more need to be done. With the enthusiasm and dedication exhibited by the brethren and our ladies, I entertain no doubt that we shall see more years of productive, heart-warming fellowship and fraternal gatherings.

To all those who made this celebration a success, particularly Bro. Rey Climacosa, our Over-all Chairman, I give you my deep appreciation and congratulations.

It is a great pleasure and an honor to be given a chance to join in your celebration to commemorate the Constitution of your Lodge in its 20th Anniversary. You are not to hold private Committees, or separate Con-versation, without Leave from the *Master*, nor to talk of any thing impertinent or unseemly, nor interrupt the *Master* or *Wardens*, or any Brother speaking to the *Master* : Nor behave yourself ludicrously or jestingly while the *Lodge* is engaged in what is serious and solemn ; nor use any unbecoming Language upon any Pretence whatsoever ; but to pay due Reverence to your *Master*, *Wardens*, and *Fellows*, and put them to worship.

Again, please accept my appreciation for allowing me to partake in the auspicious event of celebrating the 20th Anniversary of the Constitution of Solidarity Lodge, No.1457 – A.F.&A.M. I look forward to enjoying the feast and fellowship in the celebration and thank you.





Solidarity Lodge was formed by the members of PAMAT who hosted the 8th National Convention of the Phillipine Masonic Association of America on September 4-6, 1992.

Hosting the 8th National Convention was the turning point and the beginning of the formation of Solidarity Lodge No. 1457. We invited many past and present officers of the Grand Lodge of Texas: MW. Jerome Paul Vogel, GM as a guest speaker; RW Tom B. Johnson, DDGM 30B; RW Buddy Baccus, PGM as Keynote Speaker; RW W.P. Lamb, PGM; RW Billy Tinsley, grand Senior Warden, Bro. Tony Allegretti, District Instructor and other Grand Lodge Officers as part of the Grand Master entourages.

We were able to pass the information of our desire to form a Masonic Lodge through RW Buddy Baccus to MW Jerome Vogel. During the Gala Night the Grand Master received our desire to form the lodge and on the spot instructed Bro. Tony Allegretti to assist the PAMAT members under the guidance of RW Tom B. Johnson. The convention was concluded on Sunday, September 6th and on Wednesday 8th we are at Bro. Lope Lindio's Law Office planning to form the Masonic Lodge with Bros. Allegretti and R.A. Ford. The brethren are pondering in naming the lodge. Bro. Lope suggested and everybody agreed to revive the Solidaridad Lodge that was formed by our heroes in Barcelona, Spain. We devided to name Solidarity Lodge in English version.

The first year, in 1993 we applied for "Under Dispensation" (UD) and was approved on December Annual Convention at Waco, Texas. While under "UD" Bro. Allegretti teaches us the esoteric portion ritual of the Grand Lodge of Texas assisted by Bro. Ernie Arriaga.

On December 4, 1993 Solidarity Lodge No. 1457 was chartered at the Annual Convention at Waco, Texas. On January 4, 1994 MW Billy Tinsley, Grand Master of Texas Mason also our charter member, constituted Solidarity Lodge No. 1457, A.F. & A.M. at Houston Scottish Rite Building. Bro. Ernie Arriaga, Charter Master, Bro. Lito Lizarondo, Senior Warden and Reynaldo B. Climacosa, Junior Warden, Bro. Joe Santos, Treasurer, Bro. Jesus Raquitico, Secretary and other appointed officers.

The rest is history.

PHILIPPINE MASONRY DURING THE AMERICAN REGIME

MASONRY is a fraternity anchored on religious tolerance and love and understanding amongst people of different nationalities, religious and politics.


That was not the case with Philippine Masonry during the early days of the American regime. "There was a wide disparity between teaching and practice," wrote Reynold Fajardo in *Cable-tow*, the official organ of the Grand Lodge of the Philippines, referring to the fraternity in the Philippines at that time. Continued Fajardo:

"Two serious stumbling blocks prevented complete harmony: the matter of recognition and non-recognition among the Grand Masonic jurisdiction and racism..."

Racial Prejudice

But it was racism that gave Philippine masonry a black eye. American Masonic lodges closed their doors to Filipinos. The only Filipino admitted to an American lodge was Manuel Camus, of Spanish extraction, because he looked like an American. But that American lodge must have made Camus squirm because for over half a century it distained to accept another Filipino as member. Only the right to visitation was conceded to Filipino Masons, but even that was stopped after five years.

On the entry of Filipinos to the American Lodge, Milton Earl Springer, a leading American Mason of that day commented: "this would make American and all other English-speaking Masons subservient to a dark race, which I am sure would not be harmonious or tend towards the betterment of all concerned." The foreign lodges at the time were mutually suspicious and antagonistic, although all united in despising the Prince Hall Lodge of American blacks.



The Philippines then were under several masonic jurisdictions, contrary to the established organizational set up of the fraternity. Eventually, the American Masons began working for their own independent masonic authority. They wanted to put up their own governing body, which they called the Grand Lodge of the Philippine Islands. They succeeded beyond their wildest dreams. In four years, no fewer than 77 Grand Lodges the world over recognized the American organized Lodge.

Rivalry

Thus, the fledgling masonry in the country, with a membership of roughly 2,000 had two Grand Lodges—one run by Americans and another run by Filipinos.

There were, of course, other nominal Grand Lodges, the French, Portuguese, the Spanish but they were all dying or dead.

The Filipino Masons could have successfully opposed their American counterparts when they started to establish their Grand Lodge right at the start.

They have successfully opposed their American counterparts when they started to establish their Grand Lodge right at the start. To begin with, the Filipino Grand Lodge antedated that of the Americans.

And the rules said that no other lodge can be erected in the jurisdiction of another.

What's more, the American Masons, being foreigners and vastly outnumbered by their Filipino "brothers" had no right to represent the local masonic movement.

The blame for the failure of Filipino Masons to protect their jurisdiction was Felipe Buencamino, then the Grand Master of the Philippine Regional Grand Lodge, to which most Filipino Masons belonged. A true-blue, if not thick skinned *Americanista*, Buencamino allowed the American Masons to ride roughshod over their Filipino "brother" during his entire two terms as head of the Filipino Grand Lodge because, according to him, "I am an American ad all the money in the Philippines, the air, the light and the sun I consider American." Everything except his dirt-brown skin.

The Pendulum Syndrome

Actually, the Filipino Mason's case was not that strong, as their Grand Lodge existed as an affiliate of the *Gran Oriente Espanol*. But with vigorous leadership, the Americans who had even less right could have been stopped.

But Buencamino would not lift a finger, Buencamino's inaction produced an equal and opposite reaction from the incoming Grand Master,

Teodoro M. Kalaw, young, fearless, and intensely nationalistic. He vowed to assert the right of the Filipino Grand Lodge even as he challenged his brother Masons to join him in the fight to establish an independent Filipino masonic body.

Said Kalaw:

"...We must march in the vanguard, where our honor and responsibility demand that we be. Bear in mind that we Filipino Masons are the only ones responsible for the future of Philippine Masonry, which is flesh of our flesh and life of our life."

The new Grand Master lost no time in calling for a general assemble of all master Masons to discuss "so serious and so fundamental an issue." Over 300 Filipino Master Masons attended. The charismatic Resident Commissioner to the United States Manuel L. Quezon, was there. The atmosphere of that assembly was electric with a new sense of direction and vibrant nationalism.

Two significant decisions came out of that meeting. The first was to protest the formation of the American Grand Lodge and the second: to convert the Philippine Grand Lodge into an independent masonic body. Both decisions revealed the nationalistic fervor of the Filipino Masons under the leadership of Kalaw.

PHILIPPINE MASONRY DURING THE AMERICAN REGIME

SIGNIFICANT DECISION

Subsequently, a formal protest was sent to all the Grand Lodges of the world through the *Gran Oriente Espanol*. The American Grand Lodge in the Philippines promptly responded, pointing out that its formation had broken no masonic law. It adverted to the existence of several Grand Lodges in the Philippines such as those Germans, the French, the Portuguese, the Scots and the Spaniards. If the Filipino Grand Lodge didn't question the formation of those Grand Lodges, why should it now question the establishment of the American Grand Lodge?

The answer was simple: the Grand Lodges they mentioned had been formed ahead of the Filipino Grand Lodge—unlike the American. Besides, except for the Filipino and American Grand Lodges, the others existed only in name. so, why flog a dead horse?

Knowing the Ameri-

cans would be obstinate, Kalaw shifted his strategy. He now wanted to cut the umbilical cord that still connected the Filipino Grand Lodge with the *Gran Oriente Espanol*. In other words, he wanted an independent masonic body to govern Philippine masonry.

To achieve his goal, Kalaw reorganized his regional Grand Lodge into Grand National Lodge, whose constitution was patterned after the Grand Lodges in America. He then wrote to Miguel Morayta, head of the *Gran Oriente* to ask for a full masonic emancipation, which would enable him to deal promptly and effectively with all the issues vis-a-vis the American Grand Lodge.

MASONIC EMANCIPATION

Morayta wavered and procrastinated. Kalaw knew that, under Masonic law, he could form a Grand Lodge without *Gran Oriente's* permission, but he chose to be diplomatic in deference to old man Morayta, a key figure in the Philippine revolution. Unfortunately, Morayta, now 81, denied Kalaw's request.

Morayta intimidated that he wanted to preserve the bond between Spanish and Filipino Masons.

Meanwhile the American Masons in the Philippines were beginning to see the light, and began to entertain the idea that, perhaps, Filipino Masons were "worthy brothers," after all.

Consequently, the American lodges began accepting Filipinos on a highly selective basis—mostly graduates from

American Universities. And that's when they discovered that Filipinos didn't have tails, that they've got brains. In 1916, American lodges finally opened up their doors to Filipinos. But that didn't appease Kalaw who dismissed the new openness as a ploy to the American Masons to keep their Grand Lodge.

But the momentum for a united Philippine masonry had already started. The idea of fusing the American and Filipino Grand Lodges began to preoccupy the minds of some American and Filipino Masons. The new Governor General Francis Burton Harrison, favored it. So did Quezon, who was now Senate President. With Harrison, the highest American official in the country, and Quezon, the highest Filipino official in the land, behind idea, the fusion became a foregone conclusion.

The Move for Unity

To Harrison belongs the credit for having broken down the racial prejudice of the American Masons towards their Filipino "brothers." Upon joining the Scottish Rite, Harrison said he preferred to stay with an organization composed only of Filipinos, rather than one composed only of Americans.

In a speech at the American Masonic Temple on the Escolta, Harrison said:

"...But I cannot impress upon you too deeply the fact that this temple was not built for American Masons alone. There are no such things as American Masons and Filipino Masons—

Filipinos, agreed to unite they were quite divided on which Grand Lodge to unite under. It what was Kalaw feared most: a conflict among Filipino Masons themselves.

Desperate, Kalaw wrote the *Gran Oriente* once again. This time, he set a deadline: February of 1917. He warned that delay could be "fatal" to his cause. "Should we be disappointed," Kalaw emphasized, "I sincerely regret to inform you that I decline any and all responsibility as to the consequences." That sounded like blackmail, but Kalaw was only trying to warn him of the alternative of secession from *Gran Oriente*.

Less than a month before the deadline, Morayta died. The Filipino Masons under the Regional Grand Lodge promptly considered themselves independent of the *Gran Oriente*. A little later, the *Gran Oriente*.

More Problems

Filipino Masons, led by Kalaw and Quezon had already decided to go on with the fusion as recommended by the joint committee from both.
